Dear Parents / Carers,

We hope your child has settled in to Year 3/4 (Otter Class / Class 2) and is looking forward to the rest of the Autumn Term.

Your child will receive excellent support from our teaching assistants: Mrs Bratu and Mrs Oakden. This maybe to provide guidance and consolidate learning, develop confidence in their understanding, stretch their thinking further than they thought possible or just to give a friendly smile of support when needed.

Our main topic for this term is World War II and the children are proving to be very excited and knowledgeable. Please find overleaf a curriculum overview outlining all the subject areas we will be focussing on this term.

For homework, the children will have topic work - attached is a list of 9 activities, just choose 6 to do and bring the work to school on the dates listed. Other activities will be set on MyMaths and Purple Mash. There will be a spelling test every week where the children test each other. There will also be a "spot test" every six weeks in which ten random words are chosen from the previous weeks. Words which the children spell wrongly in their work will be written in their Planner for them to learn. Please continue to read with your child at least once a day.

There are three P.E. sessions each week on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays - both indoor and outdoor kit is needed in school at all times.
