

Mathematics

The children will continue the development of multiplication and division. They will also be learning about fractions and decimals so let them help you shop and handle money where possible ! We will also be getting more active in our lessons with a programme called Maths of the day

PSHE

The children will explore what makes up their identity and begin to understand aspects of other people's identities. They will learn about different communities that exist in the UK and consider some of the different views, lifestyles and beliefs people have. They will understand about stereotyping and the importance of challenging it.

Literacy

The children will be learning about modern Egypt to get a better sense of the past. This work will include children writing some of their own persuasive texts, getting creative with their writing, looking at and acting out Egyptian play-scripts as well as writing some Instructional texts.

Topic

As you are well aware our topic this term is Ancient Egypt. They will be looking at putting events onto a timeline, understanding the importance of the River Nile, Egyptian food and mummification. If you have any favourite Egyptian dishes then do share them with us as we too will be cooking this term.

In March we will also be going to New Walk Museum as part of our topic.
