

## Mathematics

The children will continue to learn about place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and money. They will also continue to develop their understanding of shape and space, including data presentation and time over the course of the term. My Maths e-homework will be set on a regular basis.

## PSHE

The children will contribute to discussions about how rules make the classroom a place where they can learn safely and happily. They will be able to identify people in their support networks, whom they know in different contexts of their lives.

## Literacy

The children will be looking at folk stories from India and writing their own. They will also look at information texts and biographical writing. These will, wherever possible, link to their topic of Indian and displayed in class.

## Topic

This term we will be studying India. They will look at the geography of India including the weather and formation of mountains. In addition, they will look at transport, food and national symbols as well as traditions, including festivals. To enrich their learning further they will visit the Swaminarayan Mandir in Leicester and enjoy an Indian meal at Bobby's Restaurant. The pick and mix homework can be handed in every few weeks and is set to further develop the children's interests in this topic.

## D&T / Art

In art the children will focus on textiles, taking inspiration from Indian animals, and use embroidery to create a class montage.

In DT the children will design and make their own moving Tuk-tuk.

## P.E.

The children will learn new skills to play invasion games, learn Indian dances and perform in gymnastics. Both indoor and outdoor PE kit needs to be in school every day. Long hair needs to be tied back please.

## Religious Education

The children will consider what happens in an act of worship in the Hindu home as well as learning about other faiths in Indian society.

## Science

In Science we will be learning about Life Processes: living and non-living things around us, identifying different animals and their features, planning menus and looking after our teeth.
