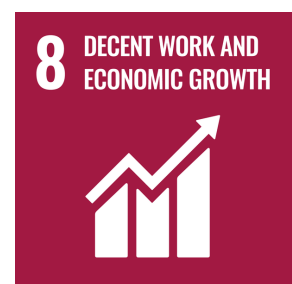
Our Goalkeeper Award recognises those who, inspired by our curriculum and call for global citizenship, independently take action to address one or more of the Global Goals.



# BECOME A GOALKEEPER

Global citizenship is at the heart of our curriculum at Foxton. We learn about the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals - a shared blueprint for peace and prosperity for people and the planet - in a range of different contexts.

Inspired by the goals, many children choose to take action in and around their local community to make a real difference towards an issue they care deeply about. Our Goalkeeper Award looks to acknowledge these individuals and celebrate their commitment to the Global Goals. Holders earn the right to wear a special pin badge on their school uniform for the remainder of their time at Foxton.

## CRITERIA

To earn the award, you have to:

- Ask your parent or carer for permission and ask them to read this booklet carefully
- Choose a Global Goal that you feel passionately about
- Think about a project that could make a real difference towards achieving the goal (see list of examples for guidance)
- At this point, come and speak to Mr Norman about your plans. He will listen and might make suggestions about how you could improve things
- Once agreed, complete your activity with a parent, carer or other trusted adult
- Take lots of photos and bring your evidence into school
- Be prepared to share with the rest of the school what you have done and why it will make a difference

## EXAMPLE ACTIVITIES

The following list is just to give an idea of the type of project you might wish to undertake.

- Spend half a day litter picking in your local area
- Collect items for a food parcel and donate to a local food bank
- Build a bird/insect house to encourage wildlife in your garden
- Fundraise or volunteer for a charity that is linked to our Global Goals
- Reduce electricity or plastic consumption at home, then, encourage others to do the same
- Create a website or online campaign linked to the Global Goals
- The possibilities are endless!
